
- New York State has \$19 billion in unclaimed money
- Every day we return over \$1.5 million to individuals, companies, non-profit organizations and municipalities
- We returned \$504 million of lost money in State Fiscal Year 2023-2024
- Largest claim ever paid was \$12 million in 2023 to heirs of an estate
- Average claim is \$50-\$100

Source of Funds (4/23 – 3/24)



- Largest amount unclaimed is about \$9.2 million for an estate
- We oversee more than 51 million accounts with some funds dating back to the 1940s
- Some accounts can accrue 5% interest annually for up to five years, such as savings accounts and time deposits
- No fee to file a claim for your lost money
- Claims can be submitted online at osc.ny.gov/unclaimed-funds
